

BOS Members Present: J. Hotchkiss, J. Bailey, T. Laughey

Signature/Action:

- T. Laughey makes a motion to accept the minutes from the 5-12-14 meeting. J. Bailey seconds. All in favor.
- BOS approved the ordering of 6 new Flags
- Abatements were signed
- Timber cuts were signed

Old Business:

- Deb presented the BOS with the Deed list for the town. She will check all the certified and make sure she has everything. She at this time is only going to deed land only. The BOS will send out one final letter to the individuals on this list that have homes.
- Joe spoke about the two quotes we received regarding the air conditioning. One came in at \$19,450 and the other at \$21,583. The third one was never received. Talk regarding just purchasing a few air conditioners to cool the entire building to save funds. Utilizing the current air conditioning system for just the PD. John Mammone is going to loan the town an air conditioner in the meantime to see if one will cool the first floor before purchasing anything.
- Police cruiser- there was one bid that came in for the amount of \$860.00. T. Laughey makes a motion to accept that bid for \$860.00; J. Bailey seconds, all in favor. Laura will contact the individual and come up with a bill of sale.

Other Business:

- Jenna Blackburn questioned a band permit. Last year she hosted a party with a live band and was told to shut down the party because she did not have a band permit???? Graduation is coming up and she would like to host a graduation party with no issues. Terri advised her that she needed to fill out an event application and turn it into the Police Department. Also spoke about parking concerns. Parking should only be on one side of the road and make sure it is passable for emergency vehicles. Terri also made it clear that even if you have an event permit if people complain about noise, the Police could come shut down the party.
- John Mammone spoke regarding demolition permit. He stated that all the paperwork and time inspecting is done the same as a building permit but currently the town does not charge a fee. BOS discussion on the amount of the fee, currently a building permit for administration fee is \$65.00. T. Laughey motioned making it \$40.00 for demolition. J. Bailey seconds. All in favor.
- J. Hotchkiss updated all the flagpoles that were installed on Friday. The hardware still needs to be installed.
- J. Hotchkiss was recognized as volunteer of the year from the Strafford County Regional Planning.
- Discussion on needing purchase orders over \$250.00 for medical supplies. No prior approval needed for medical supplies to restock ambulance on needed items. If it is new equipment stair chair, stretcher etc., those would need a PO, but not the necessary items for stocking the ambulance.
