


Town of Middleton

Old Business

T. Laughy drafted a letter to send out to Darlene in regards to cleaning services. J. Hotchkiss would like to speak with Darlene before she would receive the letter. He questions for now should they do nothing, eliminate a little or eliminate the whole service. Possibly cut back hours or money. J. Bailey states that if they are going to eliminate the position they should give at least a quarter's notice of three months that would be the fair thing to do. Cannot just give a couple weeks' notice. It has already been budgeted. He stated he is not for the elimination of the position. T. Laughy agreed with J. Bailey on the time frame and suggested possibly the first of the year. Since this year it is already included in the budget. J. Hotchkiss agreed to the first of the year, but still wanted to talk with her first out of courtesy for all that she has done. J. Bailey states that it is always tough to have to cut budget. It was agreed to wait till the end of this budget season December 31, 2014. J. Hotchkiss wants to make sure before any letter goes out he wants to sit down and talk to Darlene.

T. Laughy makes the motion to terminate cleaning services effective December 31, 2014 and before that date J. Hotchkiss will meet with Darlene giving plenty of notice. J. Hotchkiss seconds the motion. T. Laughy and J. Hotchkiss in favor, J. Bailey against.

Other Business:

T. Laughy presented her letter resigning her position on the Board of Selectmen. Stating that with the possibility of her hours increasing and the conflict of being a full time employee and Selectmen, she would like the board to accept her resignation. She will continue to help the board in any way she can. J. Bailey motions to accept the resignation letter effective 7-16-14 @ 6:37 P.M J. Hotchkiss seconds. All in favor.
