ARTICLE 2: Shall the Middleton School District raise and appropriate as an operating budget, not including appropriations by special warrant articles and other appropriations voted separately, the amount set forth on the budget posted with the warrant or as amended by vote of the first session, for the purposes set forth therein, totaling Five Million Four Hundred Sixty Nine Thousand Five Hundred Sixty Dollars (\$5,469,560)? Should this article be defeated, the default budget shall be Five Million Two Hundred Forty Thousand Nine Hundred Thirty One Dollars (\$5,240,931) which is the same as last year, with certain adjustments required by previous action of the Middleton School District or by law; or the governing body may hold one special meeting, in accordance with RSA 40:13, X and XVI, to take up the issue of a revised operating budget only. Note: This operating budget warrant article does not include appropriations contained in any other warrant articles. **Estimated tax impact: \$8.14/\$1,000. The School Board recommends this article 3-0. The Budget Committee recommends this article 5-1.**

ARTICLE 3: Shall the voters of the Middleton School District raise and appropriate up to One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000) to be placed in the Special Education Trust Fund (Est 2005), with that amount to be funded from the June 30, 2016, unassigned fund balance available for transfer on July 1? **No tax impact. The School Board recommends this article 3-0. The Budget Committee recommends this article 6-0.**

ARTICLE 4: Shall the voters of the Middleton School District raise and appropriate up to Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000) to be placed in the Technology Fund (Est 2015) with that amount to be funded from the June 30, 2016 unassigned fund balance available for transfer on July 1? **No tax impact. The School Board recommends this article 3-0. The Budget Committee recommends this article 6-0.**
