Signature Action:

- J. Hotchkiss motions to accept the minutes from the BOS meeting dated 6-22-2015 as written. M. Schwarz seconds, all in favor.
- Verizon consent form is to allow Verizon to see what services the Town has now. Verizon has partnered with the State of New Hampshire to introduce a new state discount program. Since the town is a .gov they need consent to view the towns network information. L. Parker will send to RMON for review before sending to Verizon.
- Update on POD for OTH- J. Bailey found a POD that would cost approximately \$75.00 per month. This POD is a 20 foot POD. J. Bailey will pass on information to Cheryl Kimball.
- School Drawdown- SAU would like drawdown signed. Board would like more information. Why is the start date three months early? L. Parker called SAU and was advised that due to the \$200,000.00 that was added to the school budget, the School board would like to spend those funds this summer on site work, so payments need to be earlier. Board would like more information before signing. L. Parker will print out School Budget and Governor Wentworth's tuition agreement for board to review.

- J. Hotchkiss real aloud Community Actions letter requesting amount the town could provide in 2016. J. Hotchkiss mentioned that the amount given is approved from the townspeople at town meeting. L. Parker will research how much has been given in the past.
- Waste Management update- No flier has been received from Waste Management for review as of today.
- No work has been started on the OTH. Still waiting for paperwork approval.

Public Participation

- J. Coskie asked about refrigerators on recycle day. M. Schwarz stated that they would have to be free of Freon. If cannot remove the Freon, possibly dropping the refrigerator to Farmington Appliance.
- Cemetery is still a work in progress.

- Rochester Times is no longer free. M. Schwarz suggested a pay paper box outside Municipal Building. J. Coskie will look into this option. This would allow residents to buy a Rochester Times locally.
