- Department Head:
 - CEO- J. Mammone, three new homes are being built and possibly three more to come.
 - Assessing- J. Hotchkiss read aloud P. Frazier's monthly report.
 - Highway- R. Washburn states new International truck should be done by end of month. Nicola road work has started. The gravel on Drew is for the Nicola Road Construction. Burke's Tree Service has taken down all the necessary trees on Nicola and New Portsmouth Road. 95 & 99 truck should go out to bid in September. Possible cell tower location on Kings Highway. Logging on Beech Tree should be completed before Nicola Road is paved. There should be a request for a meeting on site plans for new highway garage.
 - Town Clerk/Tax Collector- D. O'Toole will be mailing approximately 50 dog warrants. Informed Board of a possible re-purchase of town owned property by previous owner.
 - Fire- Engine 1 will be pumped tested before rebuilding. Hoses will be tested in approximately two weeks. Looking to purchase more 4" hose. Fire Department attended the Rob Richer Fundraiser. Fire Department will be assisting Farmington with their Hay Day events. There will be a boot drive on Saturday.
 - Police- Quiet summer. July had three arrests, 1 animal control call. New Charger is at Two-Way, and then it will go to Bruce Hunter for lettering. This Charger was purchased through the Detail Account. Police Chief's current car will go the Animal Control Officer.
