



Called to order at 6:30 P.M

BOS Members Present: J. Bailey, J. Hotchkiss, M. Schwarz

Pledge Recited

J. Bailey opens meeting stating RSA 31:95-B section III a, need to hold a public hearing for any unanticipated funds over 10,000. FEMA fund received was in the amount of \$13,005.32. J. Bailey opens up for any public comments. J. Coskie asked if this was the third payment. J. Hotchkiss spoke regarding the process. This is the only check received from FEMA for the storm in January 2015. J. Coskie asked if the town was all set with salt for this upcoming winter. Answer was not available.

J. Hotchkiss motions to accept and use the FEMA funds in the amount of \$13,005.32 broken out as follows: \$4,000 to be added to the highway overtime line to offset the overtime cost for that particular storm and the remaining \$9,005.32 to be applied to the salt line to offset that overage.

J. Hotchkiss motions to go into nonpublic at 7:38 pm. Per RSA 91-A:3 II i. M. Schwarz seconds, all in favor.

J. Hotchkiss motions to re-enter public session at 8:03 pm. M. Schwarz seconds, all in favor.

J. Hotchkiss motions to seal the minutes from the non-public for three years. M. Schwarz seconds, all in favor.

J. Hotchkiss motions to send the letter to Superintendent Welford as amended with a copy to be placed with the minutes, with a copy to the school board. M. Schwarz seconds, all on favor.

J. Bailey read aloud a letter R. Washburn would like approved. This letter is to the Town of Milton for approval of placing signs and cutting trees to allow Middleton to create a new turn-around on Silver Street. The current turn-around is no longer assessable.

J. Hotchkiss motions to send the letter as written, M. Schwarz seconds, all in favor.
